Barbara Bush, the beloved former First Lady and First Mom who passed away last week, once said: "Believe in something larger than yourself...get involved in the big ideas of your time."

A quarter-century ago, when I and the Board conceived of LIFE's Lady in Red Gala, it was to do just that, to get involved in the big issues of the time and, more importantly, to make a difference - to allocate the funds we raised each year to give voice to the voiceless and vulnerable in our society: those who are disadvantaged, marginalized, or forgotten because of disabilities, socio-economic status, neglect, age, abuse, and other barriers.

In doing so, we have embodied the word that has served as our guiding principle, our *raison d'être*, our ultimate goal: LIFE. We have given "life" to those who are deprived, disregarded, underserved and underrepresented.

We have provided scholarships to low-income students of enormous potential who desired to attend medical school and then go back to serve in their home communities. We have afforded researchers with the means to pursue cutting-edge work in finding cures for terrible diseases. We have given underprivileged children the summer camp experience of a lifetime. We have saved lives by building a clean water system in a Guatemalan village, aiding refugee women in Sudan, supporting ambulance services in Israel, and expanding rescue operations for dogs (cats and other animals) victimized by natural disasters and horrific abuse, as well as canine soldiers who have fought alongside human soldiers on the front lines of Iraq and Afghanistan.

And we continue to provide a new LIFE for dogs languishing in shelters and veterans suffering from PTSD and traumatic brain injuries by pairing them up in a unique, and highly successful, therapy initiative called Shelters to Service, at the Lois Pope LIFE Center for Military Affairs at American Humane. All proceeds from this year's 25th Annual Silver Jubilee Lady in Red Gala will benefit this amazing and profoundly impactful program. Of course, I would be remiss if I didn't remind you that through LIFE's Lady in Red Gala, we have made history: creating the American Veterans Disabled for Life Memorial in Washington D.C., the nation's first, and only, permanent public tribute to the four million-plus living disabled American veterans and all those who have died, as well as establishing a National Day of Honor every October 5 just for them.

We have done all this, and so much more...and as I said at the outset, we have done so while having a ton of fun!

So, "Do You Know Where You're Going To" on January 4th? I know where I'll be - at LIFE's 25th Annual Silver Jubilee Lady in Red Gala starring Diana Ross, of course! And I look forward to seeing you all there. I promise you that the "Love Hangover" will be worth it!
