America has spoken and following nearly 1 million votes cast by animal lovers across the country and a celebrity panel of dog lovers and experts, eight courageous canines have been named finalists in the 2015 American Humane Association Hero Dog Awards™, presented by the Lois Pope LIFE Foundation. These heroic canines each took top honors in their individual categories from a field of 171 initial nominees, and now America's voters and a celebrity judging panel will determine

which dog will take home top honors as the 2015 American Hero Dog. The public is invited to submit one vote per day through September 7 at www.herodogawards.org.The eight finalists will be flown to Los Angeles to take part in the star-studded Hero Dog Awards gala on September 19 at the Beverly Hilton, and this must-watch event for animal lovers will be broadcast as a twohour special by Hallmark Channel in October.

The eight category winners for 2015 are: Rambo (Converse, TX) in the Military Dogs category, Glory (Evansville, WI) in the Arson Dogs category, Axel (Fredericksburg, VA) in the Service Dogs category, Harley (Berthoud, CO) in the Emerging Hero Dogs category, Dax (Ashland, MA) in the Law Enforcement Dogs category; Glory (Sun Valley, CA) in the Search and Rescue Dogs category; Chara (Waynesboro, VA) in the Guide/Hearing Dogs category; and Hudson (Castleton, NY) in the Therapy Dogs category.

The final eight will each win \$2,500 for their designated charity partner and the winning 2015 American Hero Dog's charity partner will receive an additional \$5,000 for a grand total of \$7,500. Each charity partner is dedicated to celebrating and strengthening the roles of dogs in our lives, and like American Humane Association, focuses on the importance of the humananimal bond.
