He will be one of our featured entertainers at the upcoming 31st Lady in Red on Sunday, March 2, 2025, at The Breakers Palm Beach.

That Jay leaves us in stitches whenever he headlines the Lady in Red comes from his lifetime of experience; he's been making jokes from the time he was a kid, first in New Rochelle, NY and then in Andover, MA. In fact, I've heard he came out of the womb with a one-liner and one of the books he authored is called "How to be the Funniest Kid in the Whole Wide World!"

Jay then honed his talents as a student at Emerson College, then as a comedian on stand-up stages, in comedy clubs, and at philanthropic events like ours across the country and world. Of course, as host of The Tonight Show on NBC, Jay brought his comedic repertoire to countless millions of living rooms, dens and bedrooms five nights a week for a quartercentury.

All that, and he somehow still finds time to spend quality time with the love of his life, his wife of many years, Mavis, and to maintain his museum-worthy collection of some 180 antique, classic, muscle, sports and other cars and 160 motorcycles that fill up three airplane hangar-sized garages in Burbank, CA. Among the many cars are several very rare ones, including the 1969 Lamborghini Miura S, the American LaFrance Fire Truck, the 1966 Oldsmobile Toronado, and the 1909 Stanley Steamer. Speaking of steam, fellow headliner Paul Anka, who will be a three-timer at the Lady in Red, can still steam up a room just by crooning a few of the ballads he has written and performed since he was a mere lad growing up in Ottawa, Canada. His parents owned a restaurant there called the Locanda, a hugely popular hangout for entertainers, politicians, and journalists.

Like Jay, Paul began performing as a kid, singing in the choir at St. Elias Antiochian Orthodox Cathedral. By 13, Paul had his own vocal group, the Bobbysoxers, and they performed at every amateur night they could get to in his mother's car -unbeknownst to her!

Soon after, he won a trip to New York by winning a Campbell's soup contest that required him to spend three months collecting soup can labels. It was there his dream was solidified -- he was going to make it as a singer and composer.

Of course, he did – and big time! He returned to New York in 1957, got a meeting with Don Costa of ABC-Paramount Records, and played him a batch of songs that included "Diana." Costa was enthusiastic about Paul's potential, for good reason: the rapid and enormous success of "Diana"- his first number-one hit - made Paul a star.

In the half-century since, he has written so many hits – for himself or for others – among them being "Put Your Head On My Shoulder," "Puppy Love," "Diana," "You're Having My Baby," "My Way," and so many more – that he has more gold than Fort Knox!

The upcoming 31st Lady in Red is itself worth its weight in gold...and red...because proceeds will benefit three red-star organizations: Palm Beach County Food Bank and its Lois' Food4Kids program, American Humane and its Pups4Patriots initiative, and Bascom Palmer Eye Institute and its Lois' Vision4Kids endeavor.
