Hope you are staying safe, and healthy.

As you know, Florida continues to experience an alarming spike in COVID-19 infections and just recorded the highest single one-day surge of any state in the country.

Everyone's life continues to be upended by this pandemic. But it is especially hard on the underserved and disadvantaged in our community, particularly vulnerable children. In fact, one in five children in Palm Beach County goes hungry each night.

That is why I made a \$1 million donation back in April to the Palm Beach County Food Bank to support and expand its Food4OurKids initiative for children. This program, now called Lois' Food4Kids, provides meals to more than 3,000 kids at 45 sites during the summer and on weekends and the numbers are growing exponentially because of the coronavirus crisis.

At that time, I urged those of us who are more fortunate to help me ensure that these children have access to nutritional meals on a daily basis.

So I decided to make it easy to do so. Because I like the work the Food Bank does so much, I'm giving all of you the opportunity to "share" my commitment to the cause.

I've now launched a \$50,000 social media-based matching grant initiative through which I will donate \$1 each time an individual "shares" a post I originate and send about the PBCFB and specifically the Lois' Food4Kids program.
