During the holidays, the Hess Toy commercials are ubiquitous on TV, with their iconic jingle: "The Hess Truck's Back and It's Better than Ever."

To children in need right here in Palm Beach County, a new truck has indeed arrived, but it's not a toy. It is, however, better than ever, and that's because it is a lifesaver for the many thousands of underserved school children who don't always have access to healthy, nutritious meals.



When I found out about these children, who often go hungry due to lack of food, I knew something must be done. That's why I made an additional donation so that the Palm Beach County Food Bank could purchase a 53-foot refrigerated semi-trailer. This will significantly enhance the food bank's ability to deliver meals and provide food pick-ups by families facing food insecurity.

The new truck was christened on December 13, in a way that was most appropriate and meaningful to me, the Palm Beach County Food Bank, and local families in need. It was filled with holiday turkeys and food bags distributed to 150 children at the Florence De George Boys & Girls Club.
